### Known actions on vaccine passports in Republican-controlled states

Released on April 22, 2021

| *Trifecta State | Legislation introduced or actions against vaccine passports   |

| AL              | Signed executive order banning mandatory vaccines; HB 214   |
| AR              | HB 1547 (employee only)   |
| AZ              | SB 1648   |
| FL              | Signed executive order banning mandatory vaccines.  |
| GA              | Gov: "I do not and will not support any kind of state-mandated vaccine passport."   |
| IA              | Gov: "I strongly oppose vaccine passports, and I believe that we must take a stand as a state against them, which I intend to do either through legislation or executive action."<br>HB 330 and SB 193  |
| ID              | Signed executive order banning mandatory vaccine passport; HB 63  |
| IN              | Gov: "It shouldn't be mandated but should be encouraged when it is safe."   |
| MO              | Gov: "I do NOT support a vaccine passport and have no intentions of implementing one in the state of Missouri." House Bill 838 would prohibit any public employer from requiring any public employee to receive a COVID-19 vaccination and prohibit a political subdivision from adopting any ordinance, rule or regulation requiring a public employer to implement a policy mandating COVID-19 vaccinations for public employees. |
| MS              | Gov: "I don't support vaccine passports. I don't think it's necessary and I don't think it's a good thing to do in America."  |
| MT              | Signed executive order banning mandatory vaccinations.  |
| ND              | Legislature voted down bill that would protect personal choice and employer liability.  |
| NE              | Gov: "I will not participate in any vaccine passport program. This concept violates two central tenets of the American system: freedom of movement and healthcare policy."<br>LB 643  |
| NH              | HB 220  |
| OH              | HB 268 (employee only)  |
| OK              | HB 1057; 1671 SB 765; 846   |
| SC              | HB 3511   |
| SD              | Signed executive order banning mandatory vaccinations; HB 1159  |
| TN              | Gov: "I don't think it's in the best interest of our state for businesses to impose restrictions and mandates for vaccines..." SB 564   |
| TX              | Signed executive order blocking state departments and public-funded groups from issuing or mandating vaccine passports to receive services. HB 1687   |
| UT              | Signed executive order banning mandatory vaccinations.  |
| WV              | No known action   |
| WY              | HJ 0016 ; SF 0094   |

U.S. Rep. Andy Biggs introduced HR 2384 called "No Vaccine Passports Act." It has grown to 23 total co-sponsors.
