Three Primary Asks of We His People

1) Pray daily the short "United Prayer for America," inspired by what General Patton did in WW2.



2) Fast for at least three days as the Holy Spirit leads.



3) Commit to be a modern-day "Gatekeeper" who is "building the wall in front of their own house" by interceding for their own family, neighborhood, local school, government, church, business, etc.

State Directors Participation

1. Please provide your contact information [here](#).
2. Pray the daily [Prayer for America](#).
3. Provide a plan of action by June 1.
4. Work with a lawmaker to pass a resolution, ask the Governor to sign a proclamation, or ask lawmakers to e-sign a commendation with similar language. (Sample language [here](#).)
5. Lead a weekly prayer call for the Nehemiah Alliance leaders, mission, vision, and events.
6. Consider a prayer, fasting, and repentance event in the State Capitol or church on the date assigned to your state.
7. Consider recording a short video about the process and outcome.
8. Provide a weekly written report via email or text to the Founder and National Director.
9. Encourage the state to fast for three days. Suggested fast days are from sundown 9/10 to sundown on 9/11, sundown the date of your state (see pg. 6) to sundown the following day, and the last day culminating in Washington, D.C., on 10/31; livestream will be available.
10. Encourage a pastor to host the livestream of the 10/31 event and pray the United Prayer on 11/1.

Event Checklist

1. Pre-Planning (6–12 Weeks Out)

- Identify Event Leadership
 - Event lead/coordinator
 - Volunteer coordinator
 - Speaker/prayer leader coordinator
 - Capitol liaison (permits & rules)
 - Media/communications lead

2. Capitol Logistics & Permissions

- Capitol Rules & Permits
 - Contact Capitol facilities or state police
 - Determine:
 - Permit requirements
 - Approved locations (steps, rotunda, lawn)
 - Capacity limits
 - Sound amplification rules
 - Submit permit application
 - Obtain written approval
- Security Coordination
 - Notify Capitol security/state police
 - Confirm entry points and restricted areas
 - Plan bag policy and safety protocols

3. Program & Flow (2–4 Weeks Out)

- Event Schedule
 - Finalize agenda and script
 - Distribute and discuss
 - Confirm speaking order and time limits
 - Consider a back-up plan should presenters have a last-minute change

The Nehemiah Alliance’s 52-Day Rebuild Initiative is a national spiritual movement calling people of faith to unify in extended prayer, fasting, repentance, and intercession for the renewal of the United States ([see na52.org](https://na52.org)). Modeled after the Biblical account in the Book of Nehemiah, participants are invited to engage in a 52-day period of focused spiritual discipline from sundown on Thursday, September 10, 2026, to sundown on Sunday, November 1, 2026, with the goals of:

- Rebuilding “walls of blessing and protection” around families, communities, states, and the nation.
- Calling leaders and citizens to humble themselves before Almighty God in prayer, repentance, and fasting.
- Raising up “gatekeepers” who intercede in every sphere of society, including government and public authorities.
- Culminating in a sacred assembly in Washington, D.C., on Reformation Day (October 31) to intercede for our nation, our leaders, and the people of America.

Talking Points

These points are suitable for speeches, briefs, and more:

1. **Purpose of the Initiative**

- This movement invites Americans of faith to come together in prayer, fasting, and repentance for spiritual renewal and unity across the nation.

2. **Biblical Model**

- Inspired by the Book of Nehemiah, where God enabled the rebuilding of Jerusalem's walls in 52 days — a symbolic foundation for nationwide spiritual intercession.

3. **National Context**

- The timing aligns with the United States' 250th anniversary, representing a significant moment for collective reflection, rededication, and seeking divine favor for the healing of America.

4. **Inclusive Participation**

- Encourages engagement from citizens, pastors, community leaders, and public servants from all 50 states in spiritually focused activities.

5. Commitment Components

- Daily prayer.
- State-assigned fasting days and additional fasts.
- Personal and community-level intercession for families, schools, churches, businesses, and governing authorities.

6. Culmination Event

- On October 31, participants will gather (in person and/or online) in Washington, D.C., for a national day of prayer and intercession.

7. Call for Official Recognition

- The initiative encourages congressional resolutions, presidential or governor proclamations, resolutions, or commendations by elected officials to recognize the spiritual purpose and national importance of the 52-Day Rebuild Initiative.

- Getting the blessing of our government on a national and state level from lawmakers in the form of a commendation, resolution, or proclamation.
- National leaders & citizens across all 50 states uniting in 52 days of prayer, fasting, and repentance. International participation is welcome.
- Commissioning an alliance of gatekeepers to rebuild our walls of blessing and protection around our 50 states and nation through unified prayer, fasting, and repentance, as modeled in the Book of Nehemiah, for 52 Days from sundown on Thursday, September 10, 2026, to sundown on Sunday, November 1, 2026 (All Saints' Day).
- God doing what only He can do as He hears our cry for mercy by healing our land, rebuilding our walls, restoring our homes, reviving our hearts, renewing liberty and justice for all, and reuniting us as one nation under God.

Lawmaker Participation

1. Pray the daily [United Prayer for America](#) (modify for international use).
2. Pass a resolution (sample language [here](#)).
3. Consider recording a short video about the process and outcome.
4. If passing a resolution is not an option, e-sign a commendation with the state-specific language.
5. Fast for three days. Consider fasting from sundown 9/10 to sundown on 9/11, sundown the date of your state (see pg. 6) to sundown the following day, and the last day, culminating in Washington, D.C. on 10/31; livestream will be available.

The daily prayer:

Our Father, we, Your people, humble ourselves and pray, seek Your face, repent by turning from sin believing that You will hear from Heaven, forgive and heal our land. Cover every soul, every sphere of influence, and all in authority with Your banner of blessing and canopy of protection. May Your kingdom come, Your will be done in our Nation, as it is in Heaven. May the Gospel be proclaimed, disciples made, and laborers sent into the Harvest. May we Your Bride have oil in our lamps, wisdom, be rooted in Truth, delivered from evil, while watching and ready for your Return. May the hearts of the fathers and children be turned to one another. May we be one as Jesus and the Father are one. May we be a shining city on a hill that brings You glory.
