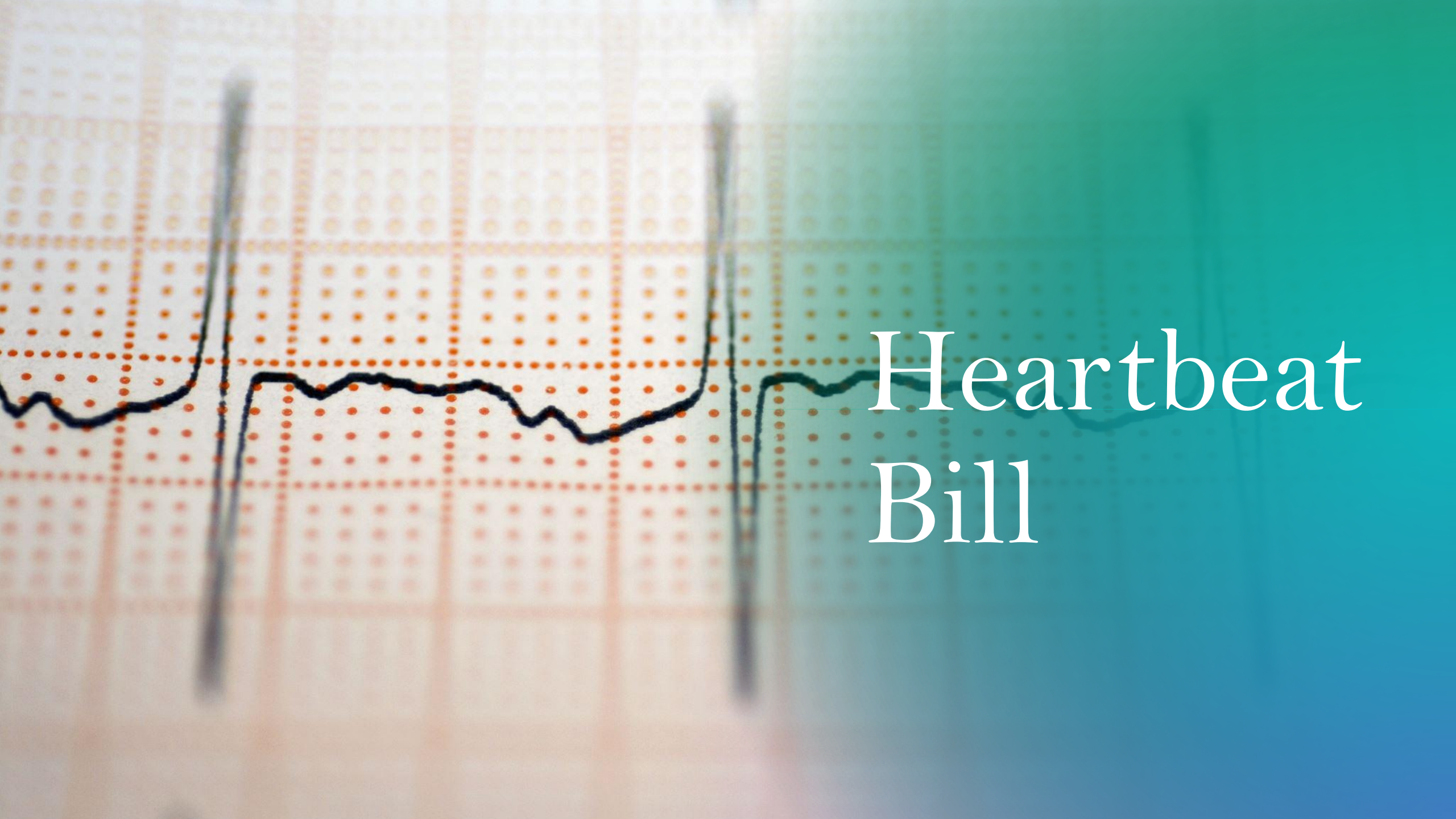

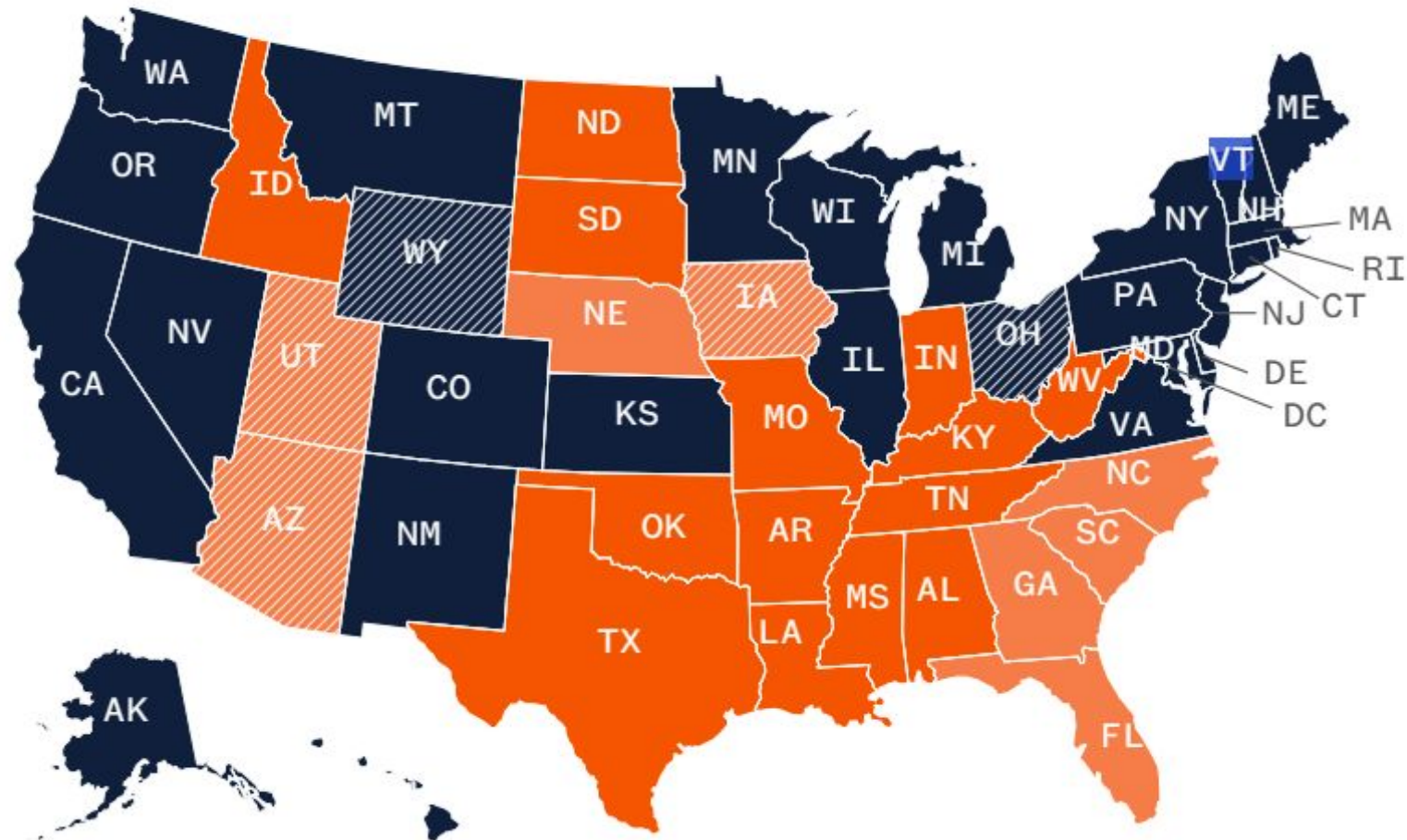

The Amendment would invalidate ALL existing laws regulating abortion: “No law shall prohibit, penalize, delay or restrict abortion...”

- Parental Consent- “Prohibits abortion”
- 24 Hour Waiting Period “Delays abortion”
- Abortion Clinic Health and Safety Regulations “Penalize and Restricts abortion”
- Chemical Abortion Pills Given By a “Doctor” “Restricts abortion”
- Laws Prohibiting Late-Term Abortions “Prohibits Abortions”
- Laws creating criminal penalties for violating the law “Penalize abortions”

Full Text of the Proposed Amendment: New Section, Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion

Limiting government interference with abortion.— Except as provided in Article X, Section 22, no law shall prohibit, penalize, delay, or restrict abortion before viability or when necessary to protect the patient's health, as determined by the patient's healthcare provider.

An exit poll conducted by The Washington Post found that 24 percent of "White evangelical or born-again Christians" voted in favor of the Issue 1 amendment. The poll notes that this group only represents 30 percent of voters in the state

- 19% of Republicans voted for the Ohio initiative.
- 65% of Independents voted for the Ohio initiative.
- 69% of self-identifying moderates
- 13% of self-identifying conservatives
- 20% of people who voted for Donald Trump

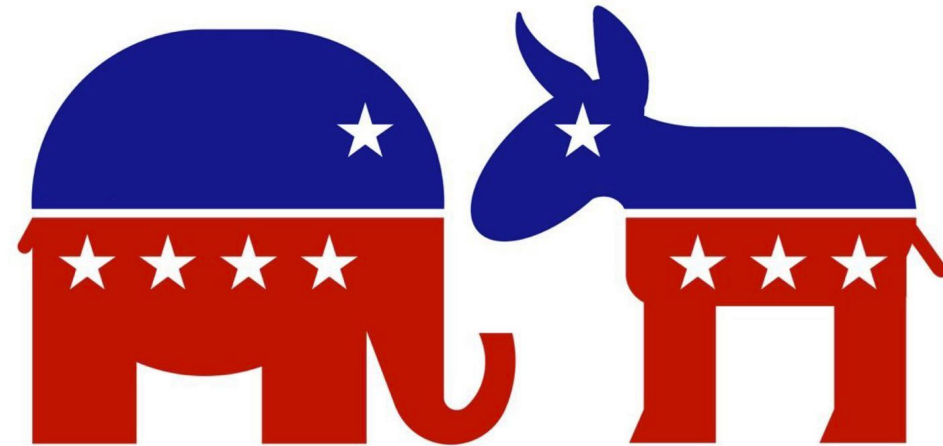

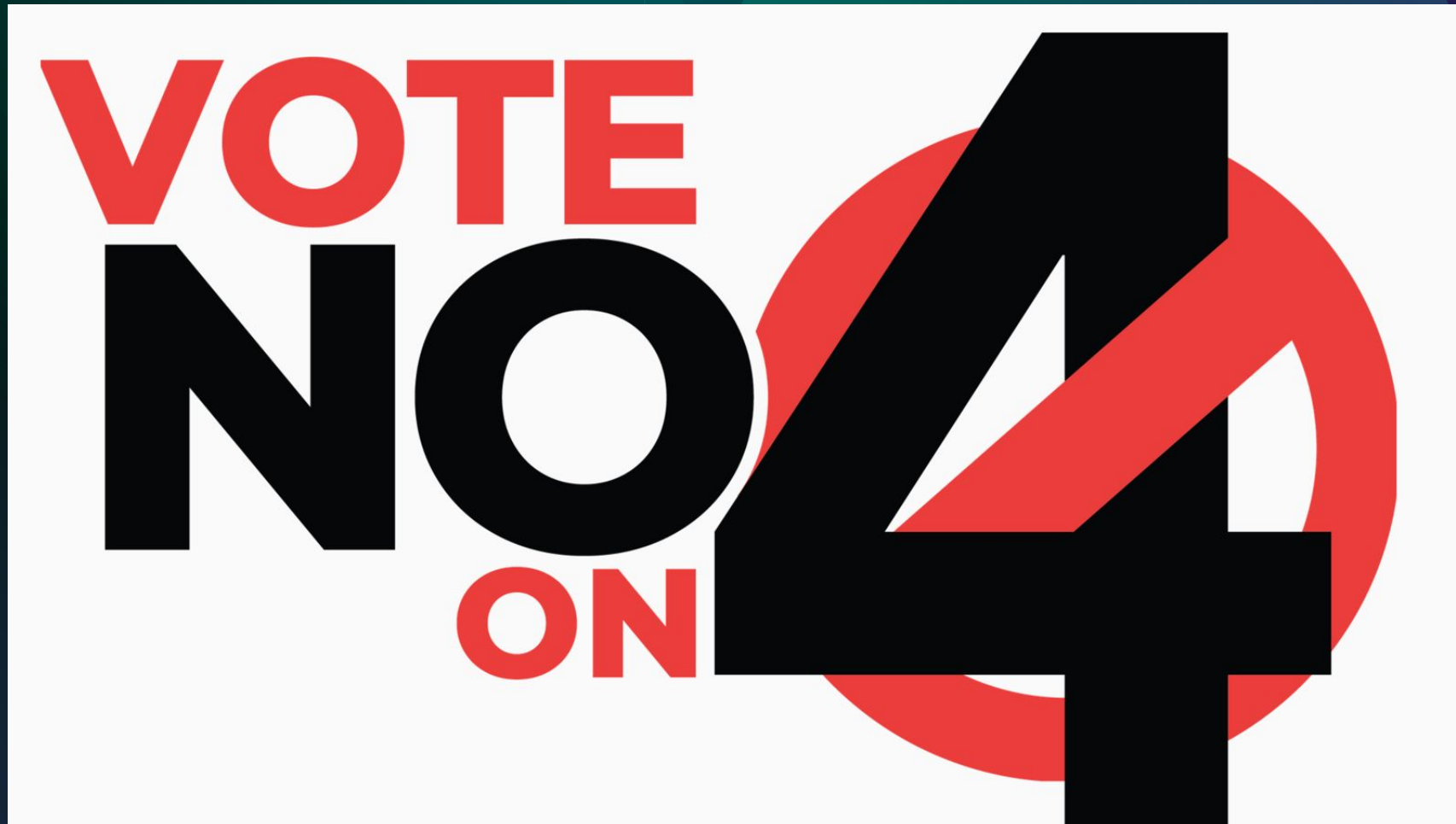
